Changes to Verification of Identity (VOI) Requirements for Mortgagees

Standard for verification of identity

The Real Property Act 1900 requires a mortgagee to take reasonable steps to confirm the identity of a mortgagor. Clause 16 of the Real Property Regulation 2014 provides that for mortgages executed on or after 1 January 2015, a mortgagee is considered to have taken reasonable steps if the mortgagee has complied with the steps set out in the Verification of Identity Standard.

The Verification of Identity Standard is set out in Schedule 8 of the NSW Participation Rules for Electronic Conveyancing. It applies to all mortgagees whether or not they participate in electronic conveyancing. The Registrar General has amended Schedule 8 in the latest version of the NSW Participation Rules which take effect on 9 November 2015.

Changes to the Verification of Identity Standard

From **9 November 2015**, an amended table of minimum document requirements for verification of identity will take effect. A new category has been added to the table at number 4. Some minor changes to terminology have also been made. The amended Schedule 8 table is set out on the next page.

Where the Verification of Identity Standard is used, the verification of identity must be conducted during a face-to-face in-person interview. At that interview, the identity verifier must ensure that the person being identified produces original documents in one of the categories in the table, starting with Category 1. The identity verifier must be reasonably satisfied that a prior category cannot be met before using a subsequent category.
