Fee Changes for Priority Notices from 1 July

A Priority Notice is a notification of the intended registration of specified dealing(s) with land. Once recorded a Priority Notice will temporarily prevent the registration of other dealings with the subject land (with some exceptions). Priority Notices are provided for in Part 7B of the *Real* Property Act 1900.

Fees from 1 July 2017

Pursuant to the methodologies and changes outlined in the <u>Land and Property Information (LPI)</u> <u>Circular 2017/06</u>, fees by LPI for Priority Notices will change for the 2017/18 financial year commencing 1 July 2017.

| Item | Excl GST | GST | Incl GST |
|------------------------------------|----------|--------|----------|
| Priority Notice (PN) | \$34.42 | \$3.44 | \$37.86 |
| Priority Notice – Extension (EPN) | \$14.26 | \$1.43 | \$15.69 |
| Priority Notice – Withdrawal (WPN) | \$14.26 | \$1.43 | \$15.69 |

These notices can only be lodged through the Electronic Lodgment Network (ELN), Property Exchange Australia (PEXA).
